



DAY 1

Arrival to Prague & transfer to Prague Castle

Upon arrival into Prague Vaclav Havel Airport, you will be met by your local guide, who will assist in all aspects of the transfer. Group will be escorted to the awaiting coach. During the drive, your guide will explain many points of interest and give to clients the basic information about the destination.

Travel time to Prague Castle takes approximately 20 minutes. Coach with luggage continues to the hotel.



Prague Castle area and St. Vitus Cathedral

Prague Castle is the enormous citadel which rises about the Little Quarter like a town on its own. Already mere glance at the view of Hradcany from the banks of the Vltava makes a visitor to Prague catch his breath. Our program in Prague will start with the visit of the St. Vitus Cathedral, Prague's supreme Gothic building. It is the see of the Prague archdiocese, located in the heart of the castle complex, the center of the city's spiritual life. The cathedral was built over several centuries and shelters numerous historic and artistic gems, such as the crown jewels, mausoleums for the kingdom's greatest figures, precious Venetian mosaics and Art Nouveau stained glass windows designed by A. Mucha that represents the life of Cyril and Methodius.

Walking through the Old Castle stairs to Mala Strana. Transfer to the hotel by coach.

Check-in at the hotel.



ART NOUVEAU IN PRAGUE

The Art Nouveau movement brought a new style to visual arts and architecture in Europe and Prague.

It was developed by a brilliant and energetic generation of artists and designers, Alfons Mucha (1860-1939) being the most distinguished Czech visual artist of the Art Nouveau movement. Art Nouveau designers believed Art should work in harmony to create a total work of art in buildings, furniture, textiles, clothes, and jewelry; all should conform to the principles of Art Nouveau and Art should strive to be a part of everyday life. Art Nouveau was characterized by flower and leaf motifs intertwined with lovely ladies and new modern production methods, methods which tried to erase the fine line between fine and applied arts, or the classical and the modern, hence the name New Art. Mucha left his influence and his legacy in the city of Prague, as there are many fine examples of Art Nouveau architecture in this city.

Municipal House belongs to one of the nicest art nouveau building in Europe. It definitely worth a visit during your stay in Prague.

Dinner at the Pilsner restaurant

In the basement of the Municipal house is situated beautiful **Art Nouveau Plzeňská restaurant**. If you prefer the genuine Czech tradition, you should not refuse an invitation for traditional Czech specialities and excellent Pilsner beer. In the evening you can listen to the typical Czech music upgraded by live entertainment of accordionist or Duo Svejek.

Guide assistance. Walking to the restaurant and back.



DAY 2

Art Nouveau Tour

Private visit of the Municipal House


Built in the early 20th century on the Old Town's main entrance, the most impressive Art Nouveau building in Prague presents a luxurious setting with an exuberant and grandiose decoration. It was built as a multipurpose site and still today, it includes two famous restaurants and a café, an American bar, a prestigious Smetana concert hall, exhibition rooms as well as numerous staterooms where numerous famous painters have participated to the decoration. The author of the allegoric frescos in the Mayor's reception room is Alfons Mucha.

Visit of Mucha Museum

Alphonse Mucha is particularly renowned for his work created during his Parisian period (1895-1904). He remains the unchallenged icon of the 1900's spirit for his feminine figures that incarnate in the best way the collective idea of "our" Belle Époque. But we cannot forget that Mucha is first and foremost a Czech artist, virulently attached to his country and his people, who keep considering him even today as a son of the soil.

Today we invite you to discover the works of the great Czech artist, Alphonse Mucha (1860 – 1939) the master of Art Nouveau. A comprehensive cross section of works loaned by the Mucha Foundation including lithographs, painting, drawings, pastels, statues, photographs, and personal memorabilia provides you with unique view in to the universe of the artist, who is famous for the posters he created for Sarah Bernhardt, the theatrical legend of the fin-de-siècle Paris. The museum is housed in the 18th century Kauntz Palace in the very heart of Prague.

Duration of the program: 2-3 hours. Walking distance from centrally located hotel.

Discovering the Old Town

Our program will end at the Old Town Square, which is one of the most beautiful and complete middle age market squares in the world. Due to the historical role it is one of the most prominent cultural squares of Prague surrounded by noble houses of all different styles as well as the Old Town hall with the famous Astronomical Clock which is one of the Prague's number one attractions. There are many legends to tell about its origins. The monument of mister Jan Hus in the middle of the square erected in 1915 is also not to forget – since Jun Hus was the greatest personality in the spiritual life of medieval Bohemia.

Duration: 2 hrs, walking distance



Dinner at the restaurant Sarah Bernhardt

The Sarah Bernhardt is a truly exquisite architectural gem that bears the name of the singer and actress Sarah Bernhardt. The interiors of the Art Nouveau hotel's restaurant - grooved blue mosaics, original lighting, wooden partition and gilded stucco, make the restaurant one of the most beautiful jewels of Prague restaurants. We recommend to visit even if you are not a guest of the hotel. This Prague restaurant offers a truly exclusive and romantic atmosphere where you will feel in another world.

DAY 3

Morning at leisure & Departure from Prague

Depending on your time of departure, participants may enjoy morning at leisure before check-out from the hotel. Regular check-out time from most of the hotels is at 12 o'clock. Until this time the participants will be requested to check out of their rooms and settle any personal extras that they have may incurred during their stay.
